



## How to join Youth on Course through the North County Jr. Golf Association

The following steps outline the process for a junior to join *Youth on Course* through the North County Junior Golf Association (NCJGA). By completing these steps, the junior will be given privileges in the *Youth on Course* program, which creates \$2 course access and \$1 range access at local golf facilities during off-peak hours.

### Follow these Steps!

#### 1. You are a current member with North County Jr. Golf Association

#### 2. Become an SCGA Junior Member- Fill out an application!

There is no cost to become an SCGA junior member and you can obtain an application at <http://www.ncjga.com> or from the North County Jr. Golf Association by e-mailing Marcia at [Marcia@ncjga.com](mailto:Marcia@ncjga.com) or calling her at 760-579-6634. **If you are already an SCGA member through a different club, you must still apply for a membership to the NCJGA's club.**

#### 3. Complete the Three Online Certification Quizzes for Rules, Etiquette, and Life Skills

Once you have received your new membership card, go to [www.scgafoundation.org](http://www.scgafoundation.org) and login to the Youth on Course participant login section with your SCGA Membership number. Go to My Quizzes and complete all three quizzes. Upon completion of the quizzes, you will be able to print a Certificate of Completion from the website.

#### 4. Return your Certificate of Completion to the North County Jr. Golf Association

Take your Certificate of Completion and your SCGA Membership card back to Marcia at North County Jr. Golf Association. You will then have Supervised or Unsupervised Youth on Course access based on your golf ability, knowledge of the rules and etiquette, citizenship, and pace of play. You will be given a Youth on Course bag tag, which along with your SCGA Membership Card, will give you access to the program.

#### 5. Visit the SCGA Foundation Website to find Courses you can Use!

Go to the SCGA Foundation website to find out what courses are offering access and to see what times you can go to the course.
